According to Image of Chile, the Government of Chile, through Desarrollo País, a state-owned company that promotes infrastructure projects, signed with Google the partnership agreement to create a joint venture company - Humboldt Connect, which will activate and commercialize the fiber optic. Chilean state-owned infrastructure group Desarrollo País has enlisted Debevoise & Plimpton LLP in New York and Carey in Santiago to ink a public-private agreement (PPP) with Google for the development of a landmark submarine fibre optic cable project between Chile to Australia.
