Overview

The IEC has published a new standard for the testing of fibre optic cabling. IEC 61280-4-5 provides test methods to measure the attenuation of installed multimode and single-mode optical fibre cabling plant as well as the determination of their polarity and length. Fiber optic testing of a newly installed system not only verifies that the system meets its design requirements, but also creates a performance baseline for all future testing and troubleshooting of the system. Corning recommends that all fiber optic systems be tested to a minimum set of standards for installing electrical products and systems. NEIS® are intended to be referenced in contract documents for electrical construction to ensure or liability to users of this publication. Lower attenuation means less signal loss over distance.
