The whole structure consists of a metal circuit, a protect bus, and a ground wire. Network hardware is connected to PDUs and constantly. The ground cable can be connected to a ground point on the cabinet/rack or a ground bar, depending on the situations in the installation site. Failure to install these connections properly can result in shock, fire, or, most certainly, power quality problems. Let's take a look at each one in more detail. Listed pressure. This process needs to comply with recognised standards like BS 7671.
